Plan an outdoor holiday gathering around weather, shade, coolers, grill timing, food holding, and a real indoor fallback.

PARTY START

GUEST COUNT

GRILL TIME

WEATHER DECISION TIME

DAY BEFORE

- ☐ Check forecast
- ☐ Prep stable food
- ☐ Freeze / chill cold packs
- ☐ Define indoor fallback

90-45 MIN

- ☐ Set shade / seating
- ☐ Assign coolers
- ☐ Open water station
- ☐ Start grill only by recipe plan

FINAL 15

- ☐ Move first food wave out
- ☐ Keep cold backup inside
- ☐ Clear walking path
- ☐ Stop decor work

DURING

- ☐ Refill smaller batches
- ☐ Check water / shade
- ☐ Move food back cold when needed
- ☐ Switch to fallback if conditions worsen

HOST NOTE / CHANGE I WANT TO REMEMBER

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Write the outdoor plan and the weather decision time separately. Do not rebuild the party after the deadline.

BEFORE GUESTS

- ☐ Shade / seating usable
- ☐ Water visible
- ☐ Drink ice separate from food cooling
- ☐ Clean serving platters ready
- ☐ Indoor fallback route clear

DURING SERVICE

- ☐ Cold backup stays controlled
- ☐ Grill tools stay separate from clean serving tools
- ☐ Refill smaller food waves
- ☐ Trash / recycling does not block traffic
- ☐ Watch weather trigger time

IF WEATHER CHANGES

- ☐ Make the call at the written deadline
- ☐ Move only the core food / seating plan
- ☐ Drop optional outdoor setup
- ☐ Protect indoor walking lanes
- ☐ Communicate one clear change to helpers
